FlexiPoint is as a ready to use, pre-coloured pointing compound which flexes with movements in the roof structure, while remaining strong and crack resistant.

SUBSTRATE PREPARATION

It is recommended that Rainwater tanks be disconnected from the guttering system before commencing work as material could be spilt on the roof or washed off if rain falls before the FlexiPoint is fully cured.

The guttering should remain disconnected until after application and until all residues are washed from the guttering.

Bedding mortar should be applied with a bedding frame to prevent holes under the capping.

Any holes which are present must be filled with mortar and the mortar allowed to dry before pointing

The use of PVA as a priming agent is recommended

Bedding mortar should be struck off straight, not at an angle to the cap. Weep holes must be used as per the tile manufacturer's specifications

Allow a minimum of 24 hours for the bedding mortar to cure before pointing

Existing bedding requiring re-pointing or repair must be clean & sound. Clean by thoroughly wire brushing & priming with PVA as a minimum.

APPLICATION

• FlexiPoint does not require thinning or dilution, it is ready to use after stirring

Method

- Mix thoroughly with a pointing trowel or power mixer
- Care should be taken to keep *FlexiPoint* off windows and adjacent surfaces that are not to be pointed, as it can be very difficult to remove once allowed to dry
- FlexiPoint should be applied to the capping with a steel trowel to a thickness of 3-5mm
- FlexiPoint must cover all the bedding material and the edge of the ridge-cap
- The bedding must be surface dry as a minimum. Recent rainfall or overnight dew can be absorbed by cured concrete bedding. Failure to allow this moisture to be released prior to application of *FlexiPoint* can cause a substantially lengthened curing time which could lead to product washout &/or delamination, this is particularly evident when work is commenced after rainfall &/or early in the morning without allowing time for the sun/wind to dry the bedding mortar.

Important Notes

- Do not apply *FlexiPoint* on exposed surfaces when rain is anticipated within 2 hours of completion of the work, longer in damp, cold +/or humid conditions. If rain is likely overnight, ridge covers should be used
- Do not apply where temperature is below 8°C, or is likely to fall below 8°C during the drying period
- Pointing area must be protected from damage until the completion of the project; finished work must be protected from rain, frost and severe weather conditions until fully dried
- It is safe to collect drinking water once the FlexiPoint has cured.
